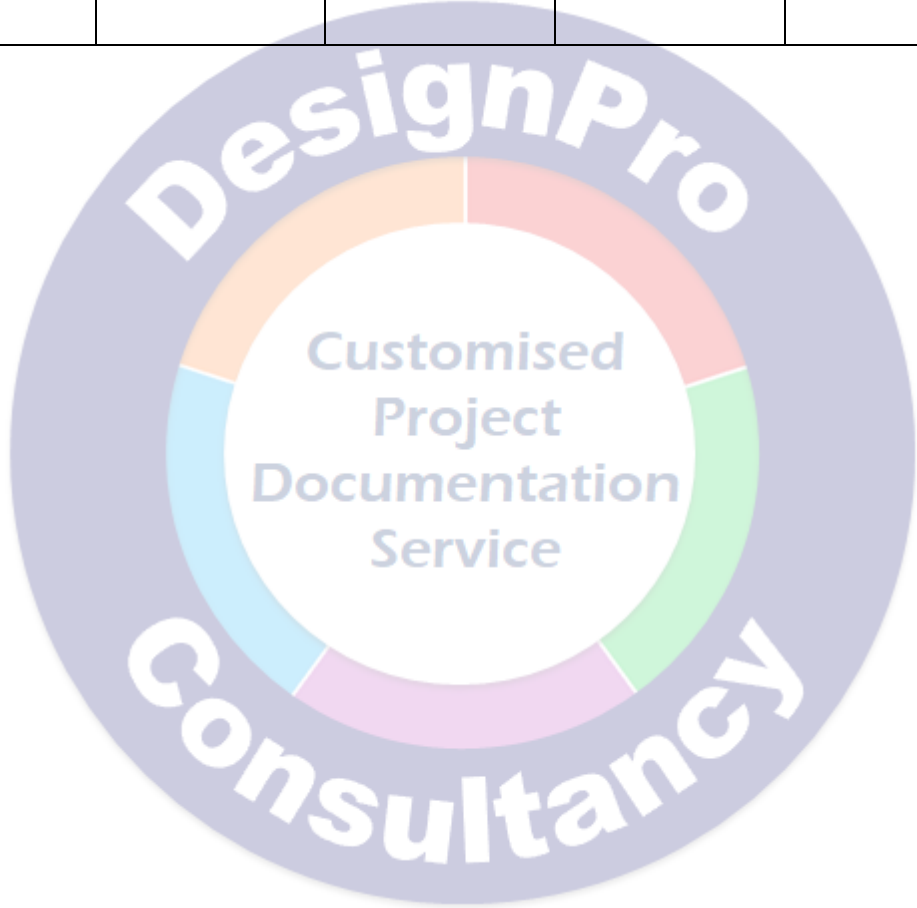

Environmental Management Plan

1.0 Purpose

This Environmental Management Plan (EMP) has been prepared as a requirement for the contractor to undertake an EPC contract and identifies the potential environmental constraints and proposed management measures specifically pertinent to these works.

The EMP reflects the principles of the contractor management system, which is aligned with the ISO14001, ISO 9001 & AS/NZS 4801 Standards.

The EMP is applicable to the project and has been developed with due consideration to the applicable contractor documentation for the project, specifically:

- Scope of Work Documents
- Contractor HSE Specification
- Work, Health, and Safety Management Plan

2.0 Scopes of Work

The contractor shall develop and maintain an Environmental Management Plan (EMP) that, at a minimum, ensures the client's environmental requirements are maintained.

The EMP shall include but is not limited to management of waste, spills, noise, light, radiation, dust, fumes and chemical storage."

2.1 Primary Objectives of the EMP

The contractor's management team will provide the quality processes, practices, structure, equipment, education and training such that employees and sub-contractors activities shall be undertaken, as a minimum, in compliance with the contractor's environmental plan, site environmental KPI's, identified management
